#### The program

The program is motivational and highly charged with controversial subject matter. It urges participants to do an introspection of their own emergency services organization. From emergency operations to station management, our faculty will challenge the students to “*what if*” this happens in your organization and to look at a way of eliminating or minimizing risk. Consensus standards related to risk management, insurance regulations and external forces will be discussed. This program will review the potential for litigation showing a close relationship with risk management. Through interactive discussions, role playing, break out groups and reviews of case studies will challenge the participants throughout the entire program. Standard operating guidelines, organizational charters, business practices, fire ground operations, training and certifications, and other potentials for exposure to litigation.

#### The lead instructor : **Fire Chief Daniel “Boone” Gardiner**

Daniel B.C. Gardiner is the retired Fire Chief of the Department of Fire-Rescue Services, in Fairfield, CT, serving there for 31 years. He is a member of the Certified Fire Protection Specialist Board of Directors, and is a past president of the International Society of Fire Service Instructors. Boone has a Bachelor's Degree in Fire Science and a Masters Degree in Public Administration and one in Fire Science Technology. He is a member of the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) technical committees on Fire Officer Professional Qualifications (NFPA Standard 1021), Recommended Practice in Emergency Service Organization Risk Management (NFPA 1250), and Standard for Developing Fire Protection Services for the Public (NFPA 1201).
